When: Monday, December 6, 6:30pm

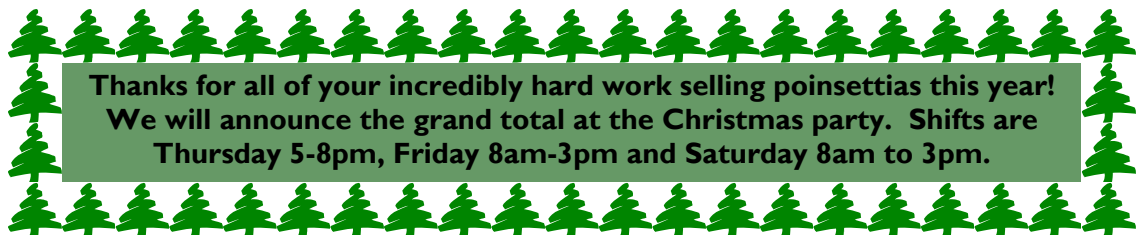
Where: Stephanie's home (112 Parkway Dr)
